## ORDER1

AND NOW, on this 25th day of May 2022, upon consideration of Jim's Motion and the UST Motion, and after notice and hearings, it is hereby ORDERED that:

- 1. Jim's Motion is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART. The UST Motion is GRANTED.
- 2. Judgment is entered, jointly and severally, against Offit Kurman and Winterhalter for attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$204,183.57 and against Winterhalter individually for attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$9,757.30.
- 3. Jim's Motion is DENIED with respect to Jack.
- 4. The entry of judgment is without prejudice to Jim asking this Court to increase the amount of this judgment by the amount of the reasonable additional attorneys' fees and costs incurred, if applicable, (a) to affirm this judgment on appeal; and (b) to collect this judgment.
- 5. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to interpret and enforce the terms of this order.
