SURVEY FOR JUDGE Richard E. Fehling**

Judge Richard E. Fehling of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania has asked the Federal Judicial Center (FJC) to survey members of the Bar to assess his level of performance. The survey is part of the Judge's on-going commitment to provide the highest level of public service possible. The FJC is the research and education organization for the federal courts and is located in Washington, D.C.

During the week of May 28, 2013, the FJC will send an email to each attorney who has practiced before Judge Fehling. The email will explain how to access and complete an online questionnaire.

Research staff at the FJC will compile and analyze completed questionnaires, and will provide Judge Fehling a report, including a statistical summary and a compilation of the comments that are received. **FJC staff will not provide the judge with the identity of any person who responds**, if they become aware of that information. The results are exclusively for Judge Fehling's use in improving his performance; they will not be provided to anyone other than the judge and they will not be used in the reappointment process.
