**NOTICE TO FILING USERS IN THE COURT'S CM/ECF SYSTEM
RE: REDACTION RESPONSIBILITY**

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania has installed CM/ECF Version 3.3.2, the newest upgrade to the system, as of August 13, 2009. In keeping with the Federal Judiciary's commitment to protecting private information in publicly accessible records, as part of this upgrade, CM/ECF has been modified to display the following message at the login screen to remind filing users of their responsibility to redact certain private information from the documents that they file.

“IMPORTANT NOTICE OF REDACTION RESPONSIBILITY: All filers must redact: Social Security or taxpayer-identification numbers; dates of birth; names of minor children; and financial account numbers in compliance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9037 . This requirement applies to all documents, including attachments.

I understand that, if I file, I must comply with the redaction rules. I have read this notice.”

A user will not be able to complete the login process without checking the box on the last line of the message. An additional reminder message will be displayed at the screen where the filer finalizes submission of the filed document asking “Have you redacted?” No affirming keystroke is required for this message.

Software vendors who have been identified have been alerted to this modification and should be incorporating any necessary changes into their software package.
