All chapters: Dispositive Motions in Adversary Proceedings

With one (1) exception normal motion practice rules apply to dispositive motions in Adversary Proceedings, including Motions to Dismiss, Motions for Judgment on the Pleadings and Motions for Summary Judgment.

The exception: In preparing and serving the Notice of Motion of a dispositive Motion, **please do not** assign a hearing date. You may leave that line on the form blank or write in "Not Applicable." Hearing dates on dispositive Motions may be assigned by the Chief Judge Frank, but only after the responses to such motions have been filed. Additional copies of dispositive Motions and accompanying exhibits and memoranda may be delivered to chambers (but courtesy copies are not required).
