## **AMENDED STANDING ORDER**

NOW, this 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 2022, the Standing Order of June 15, 2020, is AMENDED as follows:

- Effective March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the wearing of masks or face coverings will no longer be required when entering the Robert. N.C. Nix, Sr. Federal Building and U.S.
   Courthouse or when in common or public areas of the building.
- 2. Although masks are not required, all persons are permitted and encouraged to wear a mask or face covering that covers the wearer's nose and mouth if they wish to do so. Visitors who wish to mask are expected to supply their own mask or face covering; however, the Court will continue to make masks available for visitors upon entering the Nix Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse.
- 3. Judges retain the discretion to require masks in the courtroom, as they see fit.
- 4. Building tenants retain the discretion to require masks in their own space, as they see fit.
- This Amended Standing Order shall remain in effect until amended or vacated. The
  Nix Building Facility Security Committee will continue to closely monitor conditions

regarding COVID-19 in this district and will amend this Order as circumstances require.

This Amended Standing Order shall be enforceable by the United States Marshals
 Service and the Court Security Officers.
