### City of Chester, Pennsylvania

On **Thursday, November 10, 2022**, the City of Chester filed a petition seeking bankruptcy protection and the adjustment of debts under chapter 9 of the United States Bankruptcy Code. The petition was filed in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania and was assigned case number **22-13032**.

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §921(b), the Hon. Michael A. Chagares, Chief Judge of the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, has designated the Hon. Ashely M. Chan, Judge of the Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, to conduct the chapter 9 case.

Copies of the City of Chester bankruptcy petition, as well as other documents filed in the case, can be obtained through the Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) system. PACER is the federal judiciary's electronic public access service that allows users to obtain case and docket information from the bankruptcy court via the Internet.
