## NOTICE TO THE BAR

#### CHANGES TO BANKRUPTCY COURT FILING FEES

Pursuant to the enactment of the Deficit Reduction Act of 2005, the following changes to Bankruptcy Court filing fees are effective April 9, 2006.

## **Chapter 7 Filing Fee**

The total fee due at filing for a chapter 7 case will be \$299. This amount includes the statutory filing fee of \$245, the \$39 administrative fee and the \$15 case trustee fee. This fee will apply to all new cases filed on or after April 9, 2006.

## **Chapter 13 Filing Fee**

The total fee due at filing for a chapter 13 case will be \$274. This amount includes the statutory filing fee of \$235 and the \$39 administrative fee. This fee will apply to all new cases filed on or after April 9, 2006.

#### Fee for Converting to a Chapter 11

The increases to the chapter 7 and chapter 13 fees will impact the fee to convert a chapter 7 or chapter 13 case to a chapter 11 case, as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §1930(a). Therefore, as of April 9, 2006:

- the fee for converting a chapter 7 case to a chapter 11 case will be \$755 the difference between the filing fee for a chapter 11 case (\$1,000) and the statutory fee for filing a chapter 7 case (\$245),
- the fee for converting a chapter 13 case to a chapter 11 case will be \$765 the difference between the statutory filing fee for a chapter 11 case (\$1,000) and the statutory filing for a chapter 13 case (\$235).

#### **Other Fees**

Until further notice, all other bankruptcy fees remain unchanged and in effect. This includes:

- the fee for a chapter 11 which remains at \$1,039,
- the fee for a chapter 15 which remains at \$1,039,
- the fee for adversary proceedings in a bankruptcy case which remains at \$250,
- the fee for docketing an appeal which remains at \$250 and the fee for docketing a cross appeal which remains at \$250,
- the fee for reopening a case and the fee for splitting a chapter which remain at \$220 for a chapter 7, \$150 for a chapter 13 and \$1,000 for a chapter 11.
