ALL REQUESTS FOR CONTINUANCES AND NOTICES OF SETTLEMENT MUST BE REPORTED TO JUDGE MAYER'S COURTROOM DEPUTY AT LEAST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE HEARING ON THE MATTER. IF A SETTLEMENT OR CONTINUANCE IS NOT TIMELY REPORTED, COUNSEL MUST APPEAR AT THE SCHEDULED HEARING.

The following schedule is for use from **December 1, 2023, to December 8, 2023, ONLY.**

11 U.S.C. § 362(e) requires a hearing on motions for relief from stay filed pursuant to § 362(d) within 30 days of filing. Any Motions for Relief from stay filed pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d) scheduled beyond the 30-day hearing requirement will be DEEMED to have WAIVED the 30 days hearing requirement.

All motions to extend the stay filed pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362 (c)(3) must be filed and heard within 30 days of filing. If a hearing date is not available within the 30-day period, counsel must file the appropriate motion for expedited hearing to ensure compliance with 11 U.S.C. § 362(c)(3)(B).
