ORDER

AND NOW, this 22nd day of December 2025, upon consideration of the First and Second Motions for Sanctions (the “Sanctions Motions”) filed by Wellspointe Group, LLC (“Plaintiff”), against Gillian Tracy Stupples (“Defendant”), for the reasons stated in the accompanying Opinion, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The Sanctions Motions are GRANTED, and accordingly, default judgment will be entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant;
2. Defendant’s bankruptcy discharge is DENIED pursuant to [11 U.S.C. § 727\(a\)\(4\)\(A\)](#);
3. Plaintiff is awarded its reasonable attorney’s fees and costs incurred in connection with the Sanctions Motions. The Court directs (a) Plaintiff to submit an application, including relevant timesheets and expenses incurred by Plaintiff’s counsel, on or before January 8, 2026, detailing attorneys’ fees and costs sought by Plaintiff in connection with the

Sanctions Motions; (b) Defendant to submit any response on or before January 16, 2026; and (c) Plaintiff to submit any reply on or before January 25, 2026. A telephonic evidentiary hearing to determine the reasonableness of Plaintiff's requested attorney's fees and costs shall be set for February 4, 2026, at 12:30pm.
