**STANDING ORDER**

In continuing recognition of the difficulties in the administration of the bankruptcy system caused by the spread of novel coronavirus (“COVID-19”) and the public health response thereto, and consistent with the Court’s commitment to the sound administration of equal justice under law, it is hereby ORDERED on this *18<sup>th</sup>* day of *March, 2020*, that:

1. Any deadline in any case in this court under

(a) Fed. R. Bankr. P. 4004 and (b);

(b) Fed. R. Bankr. P. 4007(c); and

(c) Fed. R. Bankr. P. 1017(e);

that did not **EXPIRE** prior to *March 18, 2020* is **EXTENDED** to **May 18, 2020**.

2. This extension is without prejudice to the rights of any party to seek further extension and is subject to revision as future conditions may warrant.
