## **STANDING ORDER**

To protect the health and safety of all the tenants and visitors entering the Robert N.C. Nix, Sr. Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. All visitors to the Robert N.C. Nix, Sr. Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse in Philadelphia, including tenants, vendors, contractors, litigants, attorneys, and other members of the public, shall be required to wear a mask or face covering that covers the wearer's nose and mouth when entering the building and when in common or public areas of the Nix Building. Visitors are expected to supply their own mask or face covering.
- 2. Any visitor seeking entry to the courthouse without a mask or face covering will, if available, be provided a mask upon entry.
- 3. Members of the Court staff and federal agency tenants of the Robert N.C. Nix, Sr. Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse shall be required to wear a mask or face covering when entering the building and when in common or public areas of the Building. Staff need not wear a mask or face covering in private work areas, provided that six-foot physical distancing from others can be maintained.
- 4. This Order shall be enforceable by the United States Marshals Service and the Court Security Officers.

- 5. Any dispute as to the enforcement of this Order based upon religious, health, or other related objections shall promptly be presented to the Chief Judge as Chair of the Facility Security Committee for resolution.
- 6. This Order shall take effect on **Monday, June 22, 2020**, and shall remain in effect until amended or vacated.
