**AMENDED STANDING ORDER**

NOW, this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 2022, it is HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Effective April 25, 2022, the wearing of masks or face coverings will no longer be required when entering the Robert N.C. Nix, Sr. Federal Building and United States Courthouse or when in common or public areas of the building.
2. Although masks are not required, all persons are permitted and encouraged to wear a mask or face covering that covers the wearer's nose and mouth if they wish to do so. Visitors who wish to mask are expected to supply their own mask or face covering; however, the Court will continue to make masks available for visitors upon entering the Nix Federal Building in U.S. Courthouse.
3. Judges retain the discretion to require masks in the courtroom, as they see fit.
4. Building tenants retain the discretion to require masks in their own space, as they see fit.
5. This Order amends the initial Standing Order of June 15, 2020, as amended on March 10, 2022 and April 15, 2022, and shall remain in effect until amended or vacated.

6. This Amended Standing Order shall be enforceable by the United States Marshals Service and the Court Security Officers.
