**Dispositive Motions in Adversary Proceedings:** With two (2) exceptions, normal motion practice rules apply to dispositive motions in adversary proceedings, including motions to dismiss, motions for judgment on the pleadings, and motions for summary judgment. **first dispositive motion exception**: in preparing and serving the Notice of Motion, **please do not** assign a hearing date. You may leave that line on the form blank or write in, "not applicable." Hearing dates on dispositive motions may be assigned by the judge, but only after the responses to such motions have been filed. **second dispositive motion exception**: for a motion to dismiss under Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6), a motion for judgment on the pleadings under Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(c) and a motion for summary judgment under Fed. R. Civ. P. 56, the response period to be provided in the Notice of Motion is 21 days.
