Notice to Customers Presenting Checks

- **Attorneys may pay by check; money order; certified bank check; cash or credit card (Visa, Mastercard, American Express or Discover).**
 - **When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us either to use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction.**
- **Personal and Third Party Checks cannot be accepted.**
- **Pro-se debtors must make all payments in cash (exact amount) or money order made payable to “CLERK, U.S. BANKRUPTCY COURT.” Do NOT send cash through the mail.**

Furnishing the check information is voluntary, but a decision not to do so may require you to make payment by some other method.
