AMENDMENTS TO RULES 1011, 2002 AND 9014 OF THE FEDERAL RULES OF  
BANKRUPTCY PROCEDURE AND OFFICIAL FORM 21

The following Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure have been amended as of  
December 1, 2004:

- Rule 1011            Responsive Pleading or Motion in Involuntary and Ancillary Cases  
(Technical amendment that deletes cross-reference to Bankruptcy  
Rule 1004(b);
- Rule 2002            Notices to Creditors, Equity Security Holders, United States and  
United States Trustee  
(Technical amendment that sets forth correct mailing address);
- Rule 9014            Contested Matters  
(Exempts contested matters from the mandatory disclosure  
provisions of Civil Rule 26);
- Official Form 21    Statement of Social Security Number  
(Implements proposed amendments to Bankruptcy Rule 1007, by  
requiring the debtor to submit a verified statement setting forth the  
full social security number with the clerk. Official Form 21 became  
effective on December 1, 2003.)
